UPDATE ON OUR PREMISES LICENCE

We now have a Premises Certificate to serve alcohol following bowling activity until July 2025. Bar opening times are limited and we must have Designated Premises Supervisors to take charge of the bar. Specific training has been given and initially our DPS's will be limited to Shirley Taylor, Shirley Harris, Roy Allen, Mike Knaggs and Glen Stephenson.

All bar sales will be cash only and bar stock and money will not be left in the clubhouse.

This means we will now be able to provide a drink following our friendly matches at home.

For the rest of this season the club will cover the cost of our friendly match guests drinks (members will buy their own) and a simple system will be put in place to manage this. Our friendly home matches will also now break (at 10 ends) for tea.

There are a number of mandatory licencing requirements which we must comply with so please note:

- Members will have to sign in themselves and up to a maximum of 6 guests.
- Proof of age will required by anyone who looks younger than 25!

If you have any rigid plastic glasses suitable for outdoor use please consider donating them to the club.
